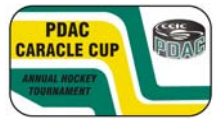

The Prospectors and Developers Association of Canada (PDAC) and Caracle Creek International Consulting Inc. (CCIC) are pleased to announce the **THIRD ANNUAL PDAC-Caracle Cup Hockey Tournament** to take place on Saturday, March 6th, 2010 from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm at the Canlan Ice Sports – York, North York (York University), Ontario.

The tournament will consist of twelve (12) teams, comprised of up to 13 skaters and 2 goalies (total 15 players) per team, playing in a modified round-robin format (2 games guaranteed) that will culminate in championship and consolation games. The winners of the championship will have their team and players' names forever enshrined on the prestigious Caracle Cup trophy. A reception and awards ceremony, including food and beverages, will follow the championship games from 5:00 to 7:00 pm.

Players from all aspects of the industry (government, industry, government, finance, legal, academia, etc.) and all skill levels are invited to organize an industry sponsored team. Each team will receive jerseys and hockey socks with player's name, number and team sponsor logo as part of the entry fee; additional jerseys can be purchased. The games will have officials and play will be continuous time (~40 minutes per game) with no contact and no slap shots. **We encourage teams to recruit players that have a connection to the mineral exploration and/or mining industries.** Participants must be 18 years of age or older.

Complimentary food and beverages will be provided throughout the day and all games will be played on NHL-size ice sheets. Complimentary transportation will be provided by a shuttle service running all day between the Fairmont Royal York Hotel (Front Street, Toronto) and Canlan Ice Sports – York.

Entry forms and payment will be accepted starting December 15th, 2009 and teams will be granted on a “first come, first-served” basis. To submit a team contact **Scott Jobin-Bevans** at pdachockey@rogers.com or download the tournament package from www.pdac.ca (click on *PDAC 2010 Convention* then *PDAC 2010 Caracle Cup*) and submit the completed form and full payment of the entry fee (\$3,800/team; includes \$50 GST) to the **PDAC by Monday, January 11th, 2010**. If you want to enter a team but do not have the required number of players, tournament organizers can put you in touch with available players to build out a team. 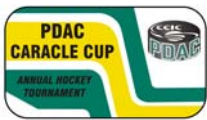

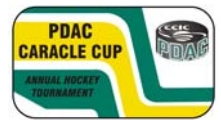

Entry forms and payment will be accepted starting December 15th, 2009. Forms must be submitted by January 11th, 2010 with full payment of \$3,800; team spots are limited to twelve (12) on a “first come, first served” basis, with **priority to the previous year’s teams**. Fees are transferable prior to January 11th, 2010 but **teams cancelling after January 11th, 2010 will forfeit 100% of the entry fee**. All players acknowledge that there is an inherent risk of being injured when playing the game of hockey and signed waiver forms will be required by each player **prior to playing in the tournament**. Tournament information and rules are posted at www.pdac.ca (click on *PDAC 2010 Convention* then *PDAC 2010 Caracle Cup*). We encourage teams to recruit players that have a connection to the mineral exploration and/or mining industries. Participants must be 18 years of age or older.
